




David and Goliath


David Chosen

1 Samuel 16:1-13




Israelites v Philistines

1 Samuel 17:1-3




Goliath

King Saul and the Israelite army were terrified.



The soldiers told David, “The King will give a huge reward to who ever kills Goliath.”



1 Samuel 17:31-37




Saul's Armour

1 Samuel 17:38-39




David gets ready

1 Samuel 17:40




David faces Goliath
