




1 Title page



2 God created the heavens and the earth in seven days.


God created man and woman on the sixth day of creation. The first two people were Adam and Eve. They lived in a beautiful paradise created by God for them called the Garden of Eden.

God said, "You may freely eat the fruit of every tree in the garden, except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you eat its fruit, you are sure to die."





One day, a serpent, the sneakiest of all animals, asked the woman,



"Who told you that you were naked?" asked God. "Have you eaten the forbidden fruit?"



Adam answered.




Then the Lord asked Eve, "Why did you do this?"


So the Lord God cursed the serpent to a life of crawling on its belly and slithering in the dust.
