





Jesus was forced to carry a cross to a place outside of Jerusalem called 'The Skull'. There he was nailed to the cross along with criminals on either side.




After some time, Jesus spoke out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I give myself", and died.

Early on Sunday morning, some women went to the tomb with some spices they had prepared for the body. They found the tomb stone had been rolled away and the tomb was empty.



The women quickly ran back to tell the disciples. The disciples did not believe them. Peter, however, ran immediately to the empty tomb and marvelled at what had happened.


