

Title Page: The Baptism of Jesus






John only ate locusts and wild honey and wore clothes made of camel's hair with a leather belt around his waist.


Now the crowds became very excited and wondered if John might be the Messiah.


Some Pharisees came and asked, "If you are not the Messiah, then why are you baptising people?"


