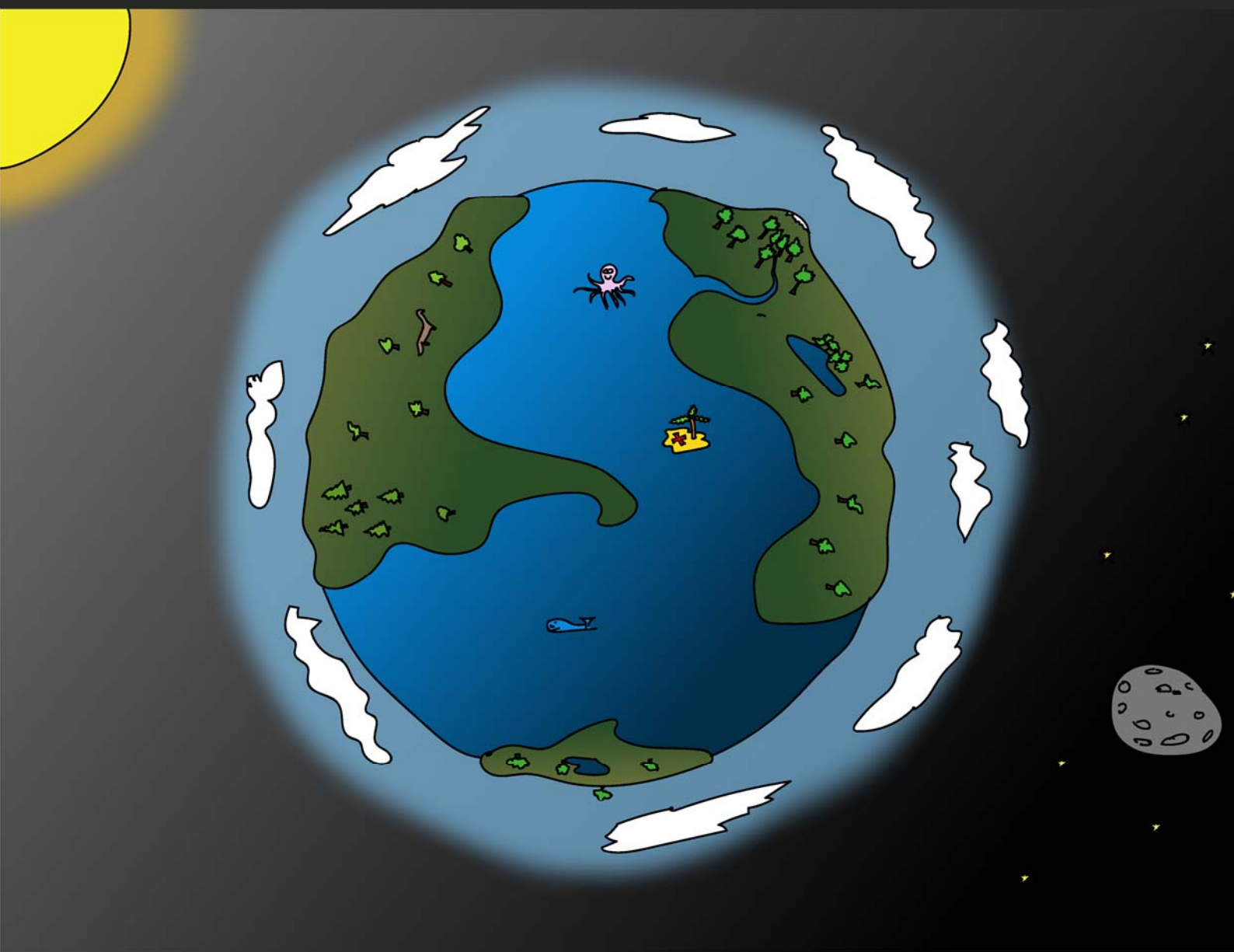

The Spirit of God was moving over the waters.



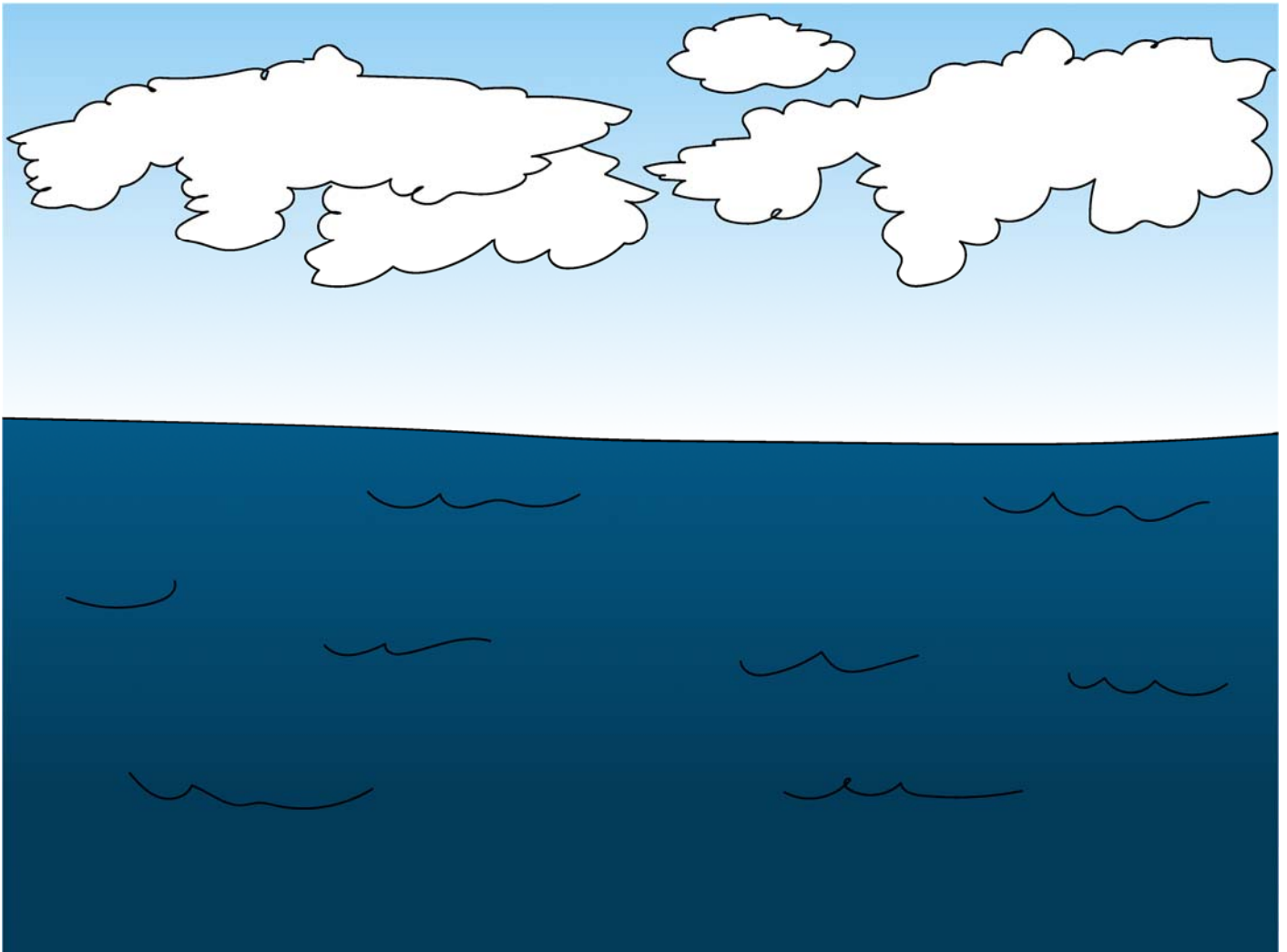
The First Day

Evening came and then morning - the first day.

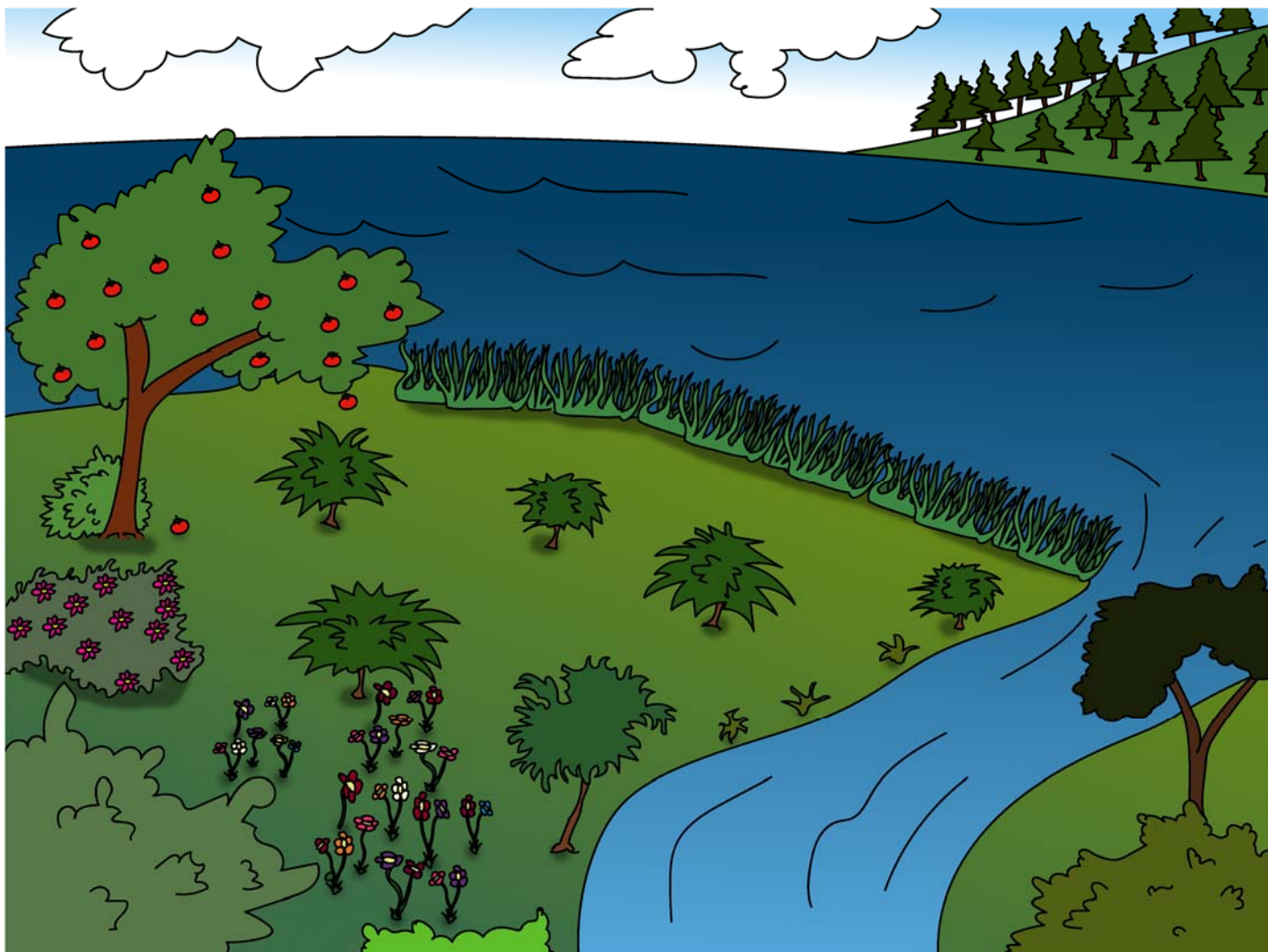




The Second Day

God said, "Let the water come together so that dry ground can appear." And it happened.

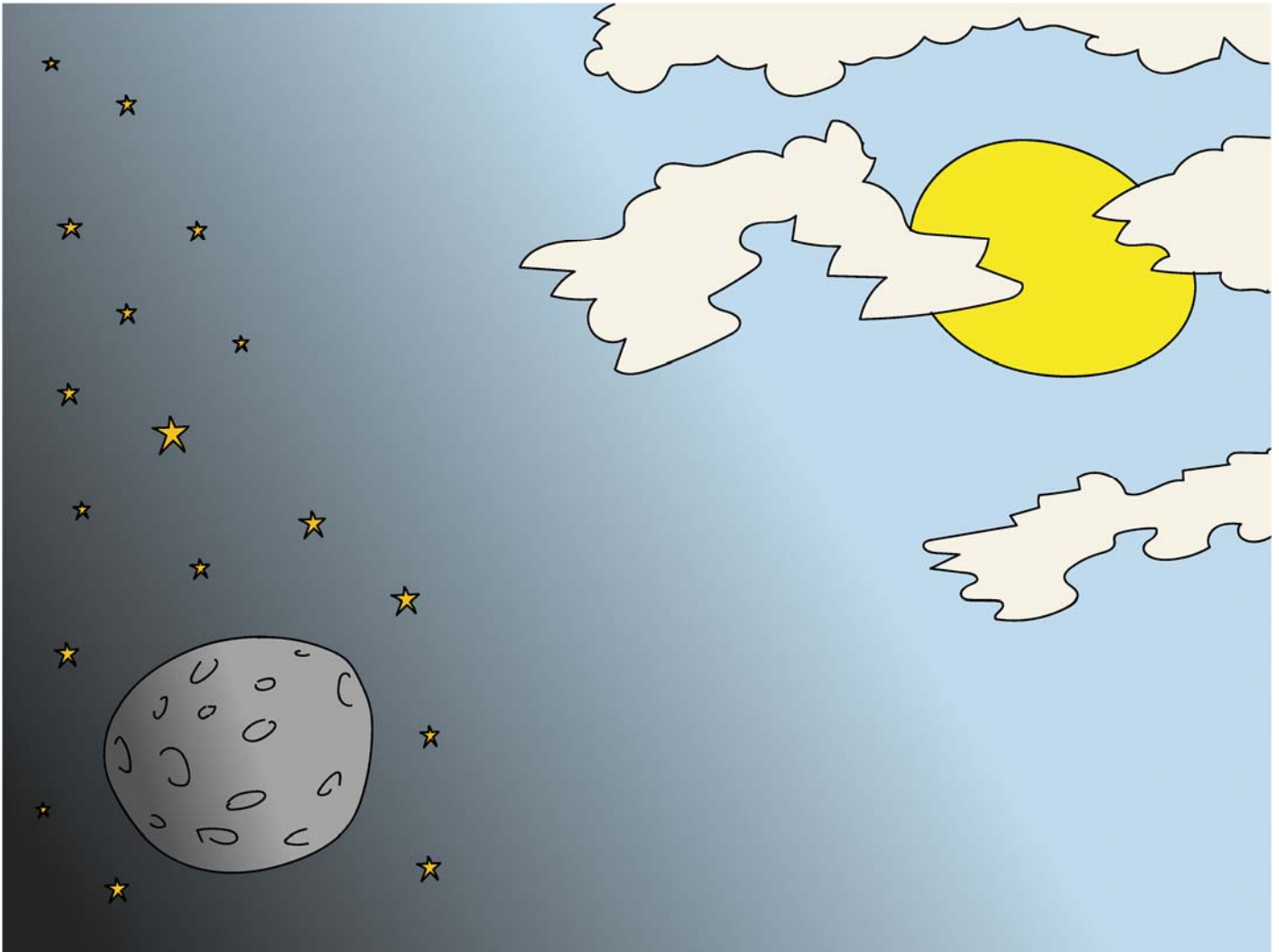
God named dry ground "Land," and the water "Ocean."

Evening came and then morning - the third day.



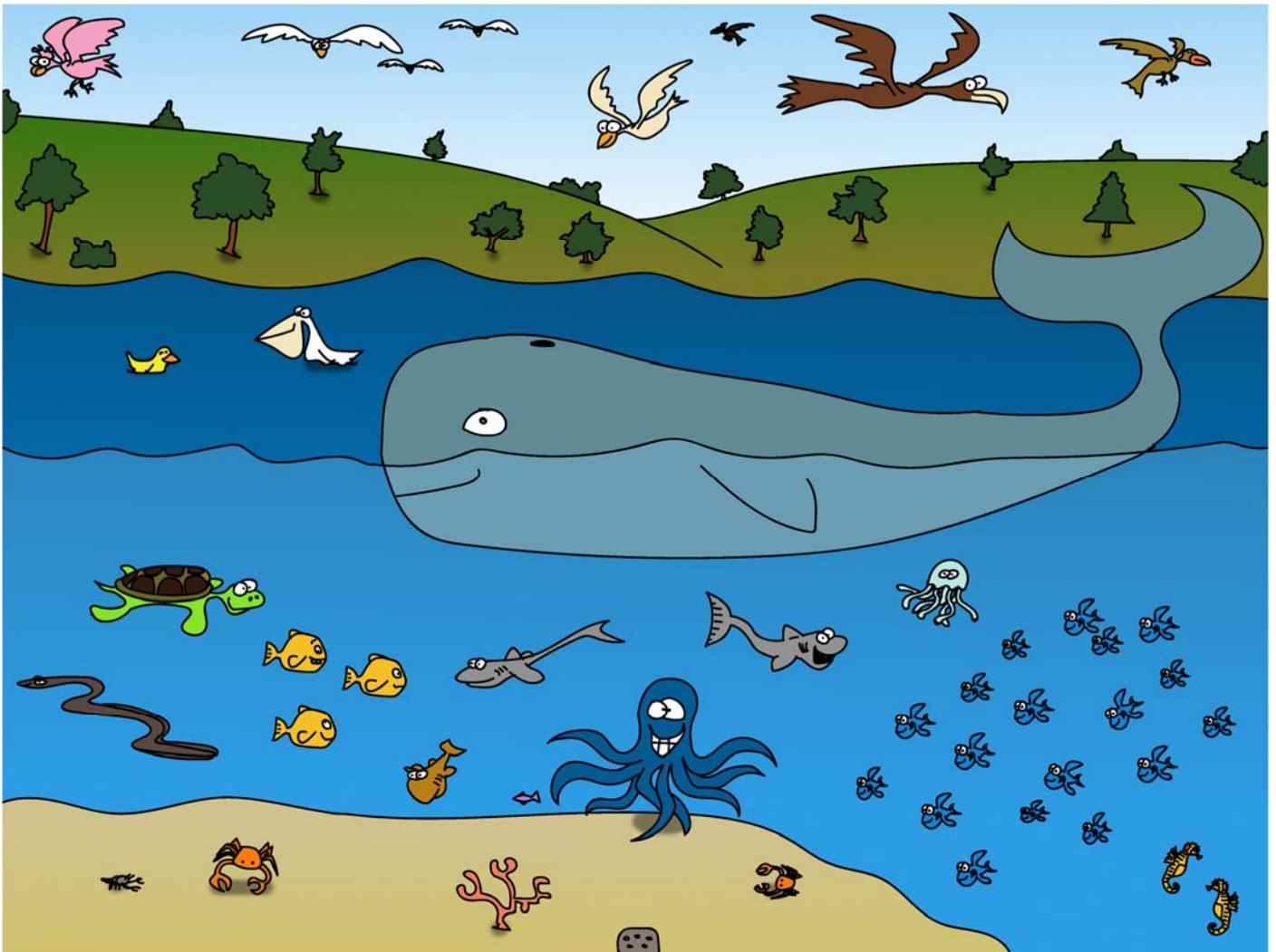
The Fourth Day

Evening came and then morning - the fourth day.

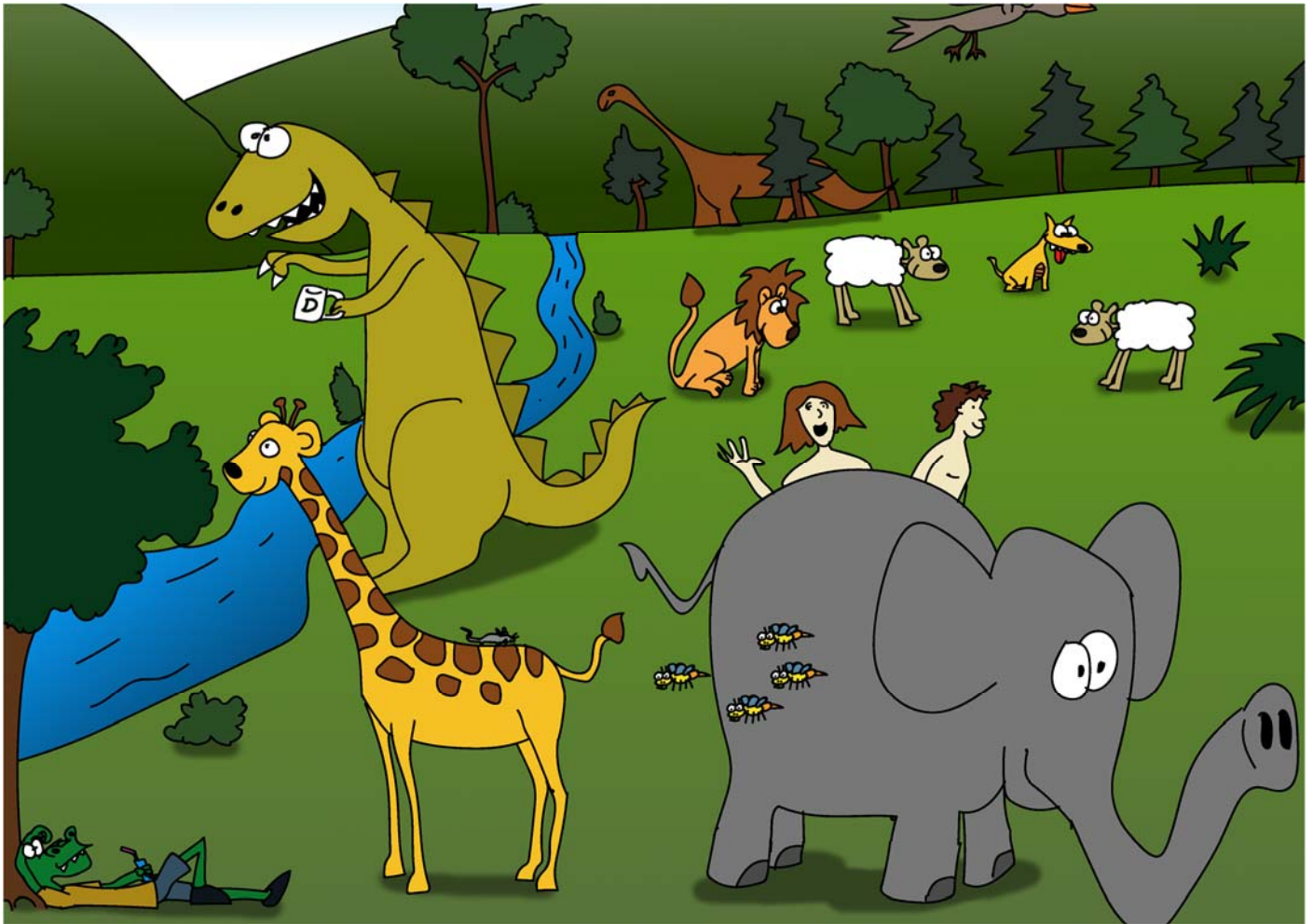


The Fifth Day

The Sixth Day

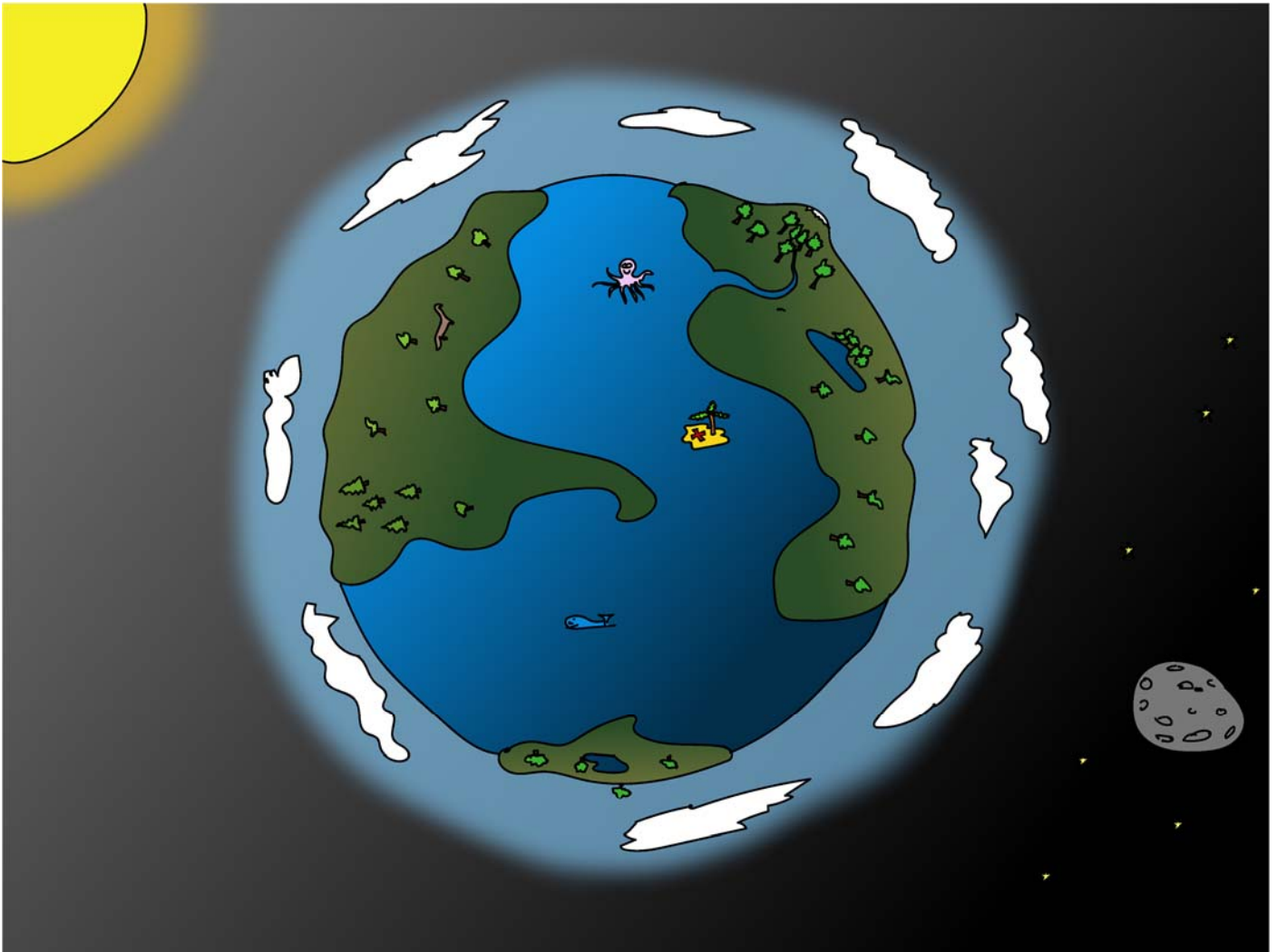
